Scholarship Eligibility and Criteria

*Please note: If the scholarship states; "May apply in subsequent years" the scholarship is open to
High School and College students*

1. Carolee O'Neal Bell Memorial Scholarship

- Open to a graduating senior who plans to continue his/her education at a college, university or junior college.
- Applicant must show financial need, faith and church participation, moral character, and good academic standing

2. Louise "Bubbles" Daniels Memorial Scholarship

- Must have been a resident of Dare County for at least two years.
- Available to high school seniors and college students continuing their education.
- Must show financial need, faith and churchmanship and moral character.
- May apply for scholarship in subsequent years.

3. Richard Coles Evans Memorial Scholarship

- Must be a resident of Dare County and a high school graduate.
- May apply in subsequent years.
- Must show financial need, faith and churchmanship, motivation to achieve, academic qualities, leadership potential and moral character.
- Candidate must be enrolled/enrolling in a college, university, technical, or post high school accredited vocational program.

4. Betty Ruth Flowers Gibbs Memorial Scholarship

- Open to Dare County residents seeking to pursue their education beyond high school, including GED recipients, whether through a university, college, community college, or vocational or other training.
- Applicant must demonstrate a financial need for the scholarship
- No academic requirements for the recipient, except they must be accepted at the educational facility to be eligible for assistance.

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5. **Woody Gaskill/Keith Jones Memorial Scholarship (Manteo Only)**

- a. Only open to a Manteo High senior
- b. Must show financial need, adequate academic qualities (c or above high school average), moral character and personality and sport participation.
- c. Applicant must have been accepted by a college, university, technical, or post high school accredited vocational program.

6. **Helen Britt Van Cleef Petty Memorial Scholarship**

- a. Must be a legal resident of Dare County and a high school graduate.
- b. Student may apply in subsequent years
- c. Must have good character, academic success, church attendance
- d. Planning to pursue education beyond the high school level, which may be a college, university, community college, trade school, or similar institution.

7. **Karen Phillips Memorial Scholarship (Nursing/Medical)**

- a. Open to Dare County residents seeking to pursue their education beyond high school, including GED recipients, whether through a university, college, community college, or vocational or other training.
- b. Applicant must be enrolled/enrolling in a college, university, technical, or post high school accredited vocational program
- c. Applicant must have an intended profession in the medical field; all medical professions will be considered.
- d. Must show adequate academic qualities, financial need, motivation to achieve and leadership potential.
- e. Student may apply in subsequent years.

8. **Richard H. “Dick” Ward Memorial Scholarship**

- a. Resident of Dare County and high school graduate.
- b. Must show adequate academic qualities, faith and churchmanship, financial need, motivation to achieve and leadership potential.
- c. Applicant must be enrolled/enrolling in a college, university, technical, or post high school accredited vocational program.
- d. Student may apply in subsequent years.

9. **Jane Abbott Zegopulus, Rn, Memorial Scholarship (Nursing)**

- a. Candidate must state the intention of becoming a registered nurse and be enrolled in a nursing program at an accredited school that will support that objective.
- b. Must have a reasonably good chance of achieving this goal academically.
- c. Recipient must take enough credit hours to fulfill his/her school’s definition of a full-time student.
- d. Student may apply in subsequent years.

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Completing the Application(s)

1. Decide on the Mount Olivet scholarship(s) for which to apply. Each scholarship has its own criteria for selection, such as academic ability, financial need, faith and churchmanship, leadership, etc. Please ensure you have carefully read through the criteria and eligibility requirements for each application. Apply only to those for which you are eligible. **If you apply for a scholarship and do not meet the criteria, your application will not be considered.**
2. Pickup a Mount Olivet scholarship application packet from your high school guidance office center
Packet includes:
 - a. Scholarship application form
 - b. Applicant's letter
 - c. Student's statement of financial need. Please note a FAFSA Summary must be included
3. Contact your school and request a copy of your transcript (through first semester of senior year for high school students; copy of last completed semester for college students). *Does not have to be a certified copy -*

Submitting your Application(s)

ALL PACKETS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE GUIDANCE OFFICE OF YOUR HIGH SCHOOL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

Manteo High School: Only hard/paper copies will be accepted
First Flight High School: Check with your Guidance Office
Cape Hatteras High School: Only hard/paper copies will be accepted

The deadline for your application and all forms including recommendation letters is February 25, 2022.

Packets will not be accepted directly by Mount Olivet UMC. They must be submitted to your Guidance Office.

Steps for Requesting Recommendation Letters

Complete the box titled “To be completed by applicant”. This is required for each form and letter written, **PLEASE ensure that if a recommender provides a recommendation on your behalf they list at the top of the letter: your name, the name of the scholarship, and the title you have assigned them that matches the scholarship requirement i.e. Teacher, community person, youth pastor, etc.**

- a. One recommendation form can be applied to more than one scholarship. For example, John Smith could write a recommendation for you as a *community person* and it would apply as *one recommendation* for Louise “Bubbles” Daniels, Betty Ruth Flowers Gibbs, Woody Gaskill/Keith Jones, Helen Britt Van Cleef Petty and Karen Phillips. **example:**
