BEST PRACTICES:

- When you set up your account, record your long-in and password to have access to your new dashboard.
- We are using a new portal that is shared by students applying for scholarships and organizations applying for grants, so please pay close attention to the directions in red when creating an account
- Only use a permanent email address to create accounts
- The first tab in your application has a lot of important information and there are **hints in blue** throughout.

WHEN TO APPLY:

The application opens on Monday, February 6, 2023.

WHAT TO DO:

Start your online application at **www.obcf.org/scholarships** on 2/6/2023. Ask your guidance counselor for a copy of your transcript and gather all the information you will need to apply.

What you will need to apply:

Aside from your most current transcript...

- TWO letters of recommendation
- Student Aid Report (SAR) for

Needs-Based scholarships

A great ESSAY!



Letters of Recommendation:

- 2 Letters **REQUIRED**
- Be thoughtful, **ASK NOW!** Let recommenders know the deadline and give them friendly reminders.
- You are responsible for obtaining these letters of recommendation from your selected individuals and uploading them into our system.
- Recommenders who want to keep their submissions confidential can email me, nandy@obcf.org. Their recommendations to be uploaded by the Monday, March 6th (11:59 pm) deadline.



Financial Information:

- *NOTE: Merit-based scholarships do not require financial information.
- For need-based scholarships you must complete the FAFSA, and upload the resulting Student Aid Report (SAR) into the application form.
- Enter your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) into the form AS IS; **do NOT editorialize your EFC** (If it does not match the uploaded SAR you will be disqualified).
- If you can't complete the FAFSA but want to be considered for need-based scholarships please contact us or your counselors for assistance.



Essay & Interviews:

- Our application only requires <u>ONE</u> ESSAY.
- Second essay is ONLY for Milton A. Jewell Academic Scholarship (our most prestigious merit-based scholarship).
- Interviews are required for very few of our scholarships. Dates and times cannot be changes. If you are selected, we will notify you using the email you provided.

WHEN TO APPLY:

The application opens on Monday, February 6, 2023.

DEADLINE:

The deadline for all applications is 11:59 pm on Monday, March 6, 2023.

INTERVIEWS:

Interviews are scheduled for 12-4 pm on Friday March 31, Monday, April 3 or Tuesday, April 4, 2023.
